INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE INTER CLUB GRADES COMPETITION
SUNDAY, 29 AUGUST @ 09H20 TO 11H50

- **NO** club clothing to be worn (skaters may dress up, if they wish, but it is not compulsory, as long as they wear something appropriate for skating).
- Competitors to register at the registration table by 8.30am at the ice rink entrance.
- Competitor badges to be worn at all times – collect at registration table.
- Boot hire tickets will be available at the registration table.
- Skaters are to go directly to Block 'C' and find your seat, it will have your name on it
- Each competitor will receive a certificate after skating.
- **VERY IMPORTANT:** Certificates - please check the spelling of your child's name on the list (No reprints will be entertained).
- After skaters have finished competing they will be taken to have their photo taken (included in the registration cost) – please ensure that your child receives his/her photo before leaving the rink, as we cannot guarantee you will be able to get it later.
- Additional photos and podium shots - R30 (by own arrangement with photographer).
- Once the Inter Club Competition is finished, and the ice is being resurfaced, skaters are permitted to sit with their parents to watch the rest of the competition.
- We encourage skaters to stay to the end and support the other competitors.
- Results will be displayed on the noticeboard.
- Please ensure that your child is seated back in his/her seat in Block 'C' by 12h45. **PLEASE PUT SKATES ON**
- At 13h00, there is a parade of all skaters, including the Inter Club Grades competitors, and on ice for presentations (**VERY IMPORTANT:** skaters are to remain with the coaches on the ice and to stand still during the presentation of awards – or they will be asked to leave the ice and may miss their opportunity on the podium.)
